Background:	The alpha 2C Adrenergic Receptor controls the release of neurotransmitter from central adrenergic neurons and from sympathetic nerves in the heart. This receptor also plays a role in cognitive and behavioral function. Two variants are produced by alternative splicing. Alpha 2C Adrenergic Receptor has been reported extensively in the brain. Blood, corpus cavernosum, kidney, and heart tissues have also been reported to express the protein.

Note:	Detects 50kDa or larger (possibly due to dimerization). Does not cross-react with other adrenergic receptors.
