**Background:** This gene encodes a member of the short-chain nonmetalloenzyme alcohol dehydrogenase

protein family. The encoded enzyme is responsible for the metabolism of prostaglandins, which function in a variety of physiologic and cellular processes such as inflammation. Mutations in this gene result in primary autosomal recessive hypertrophic osteoarthropathy and cranioosteoarthropathy. Multiple transcript variants encoding different isoforms have

been found for this gene. [provided by RefSeq]









### **Product images:**



HEK293T cells were transfected with the pCMV6-ENTRY control (Left lane) or pCMV6-ENTRY HPGD ([RC204160], Right lane) cDNA for 48 hrs and lysed. Equivalent amounts of cell lysates (5 ug per lane) were separated by SDS-PAGE and immunoblotted with anti-HPGD. Positive lysates [LY400305] (100ug) and [LC400305] (20ug) can be purchased separately from OriGene.











